



On May 31, 2016 “Junior Archaeologist’s” school launched its practical courses. Representing the special educational excavation area, the director of the museum Mr. Gagik Gyurjyan wished good luck to all the junior archaeologists and emphasized that all the archaeological knowledge, that they received during the theoretical courses they would apply during the excavations.

The “Junior Archaeologist’s” school is a project conducted by the “Erebuni” Historical & Archaeological Museum-Reserve. The duration of the theoretical classes is 2 weeks with the 3 lessons per week.
